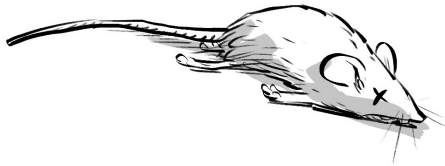


Experience the fun of summer camp in this STEM-themed chapter book series!

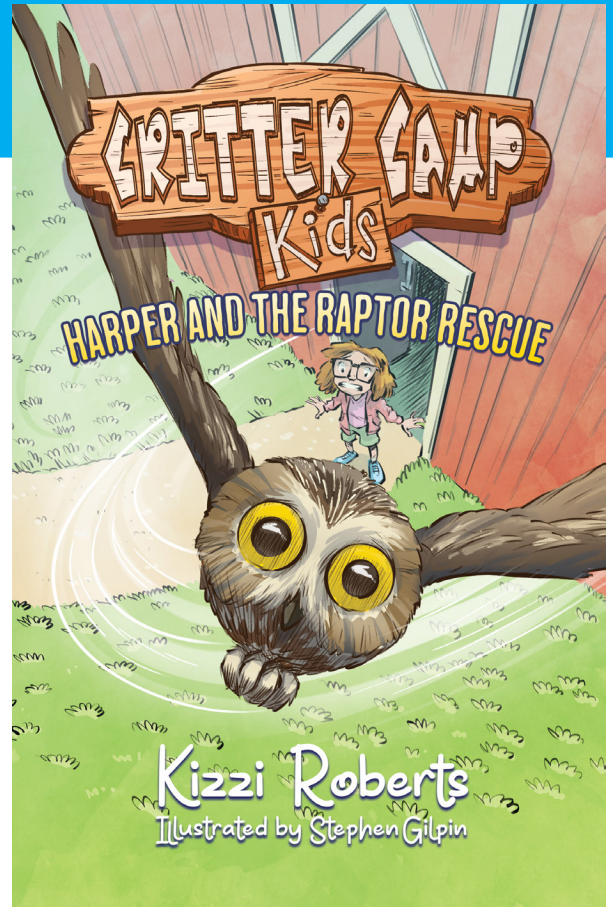
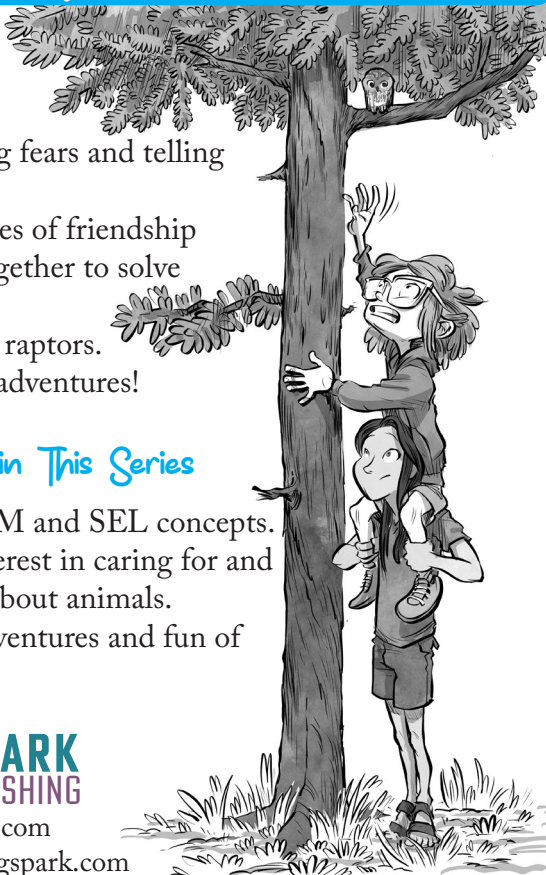
